## Admission Examination Scholarship 2013/2014

Our University offers “Admission Examination Scholarship” and “Admission Examination Special Scholarship” to Admission Examination candidates with outstanding performance in our Admission Examination. Scholarship recipients will be individually notified by the University upon release of the Admission Examination results. Candidates do not need to submit applications for this scholarship and individual scholarship recipients will be notified by phone.

### 1. Eligibility

- a. Scholarship selection is made based on a candidate’s Admission Examination result, not including the additional marks added through Preferential Admission Scheme.
- b. All eligible candidates must have sat for the Admission Examinations and be registered students of the current academic year.
- c. Candidates who have been exempted from taking particular Admission Examination subject(s) will not be eligible for selection of an Admission Examination Scholarship.

### 2. Scholarship and duration

#### a. “Admission Examination Scholarship”:

“Admission Examination Scholarship” candidates will be exempted from 100% of tuition fees in their first year of study. They can enjoy a scholarship which entitles them to half to full tuition fee waiver during 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year of study, subject to their yearly academic performance. The “Admission Examination Scholarship” can cover 4 years at most, except for Bachelor of Law (Taught in Portuguese Five-year Evening Programme).

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year, the continuation of “Admission Examination Scholarship” scheme will be as follows:

- Scholarship candidates must achieve satisfactory results in their previous academic year of study to continue their scholarship eligibility. Evaluation is based on each academic year’s performance (yearly GPA) and not cumulative performance (cumulative GPA);

- Scholarship candidates must have obtained at least 15 credits for each semester of the academic year.

\* The highest letter grade is A (GPA=4.00), followed by A- (GPA=3.70), B+ (GPA=3.30), etc.

- b. “Admission Examination Special Scholarship”:

“Admission Examination Special Scholarship” recipients will receive a one-off scholarship of MOP\$5,000 tuition fee waiver in their first year of study. This amount will be used to offset part of the tuition fees payable for the second semester in the first year of study.

### 3. Termination of scholarship

- a. If a candidate accepts scholarships through Principals’ Recommended Admission scheme of the current year, he/she is not permitted to attend the Admission Examination. If he/she is found to have applied for or to have attended the Admission Examination and is granted a scholarship for Admission Examination candidates, the University reserves the right to remove his/her qualifications for both scholarship schemes.
- b. The University reserves the right to disqualify the candidate’s scholarship if the candidate:
- cannot achieve the academic year’s performance mentioned above;
  - cannot complete his/her study within the normative period of study;
  - changes programme of study;
  - defers his/her study.
