## Principals' Recommended Admission Scholarship Scheme 2013/2014

### 1. Qualifications

- All students granted with the "Principals' Recommended Admission Scholarship", subject to their yearly academic performance, can continue enjoying half to full tuition fee waiver during 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> academic year of study (during 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> academic year of study for Bachelor of Law in Portuguese language of five year evening programme);
- Scholarship candidates must achieve satisfactory results in their previous academic year of study as to continue the eligibility of scholarship. Evaluation is based on each academic year's performance (yearly GPA) and not cumulative performance (such as cumulative GPA);
- Bachelor's degree students must have passed at least 15 credits for each semester of the academic year.

### 2. Scholarship Scheme

\* The highest letter grade is A (GPA=4.00), followed by A- (GPA=3.70), B+ (GPA=3.30), etc.

  - cannot achieve the academic year's performance mentioned above;
  - cannot complete his/her study within the normal period of study;
  - changes programmes;
  - defers his/her study.
